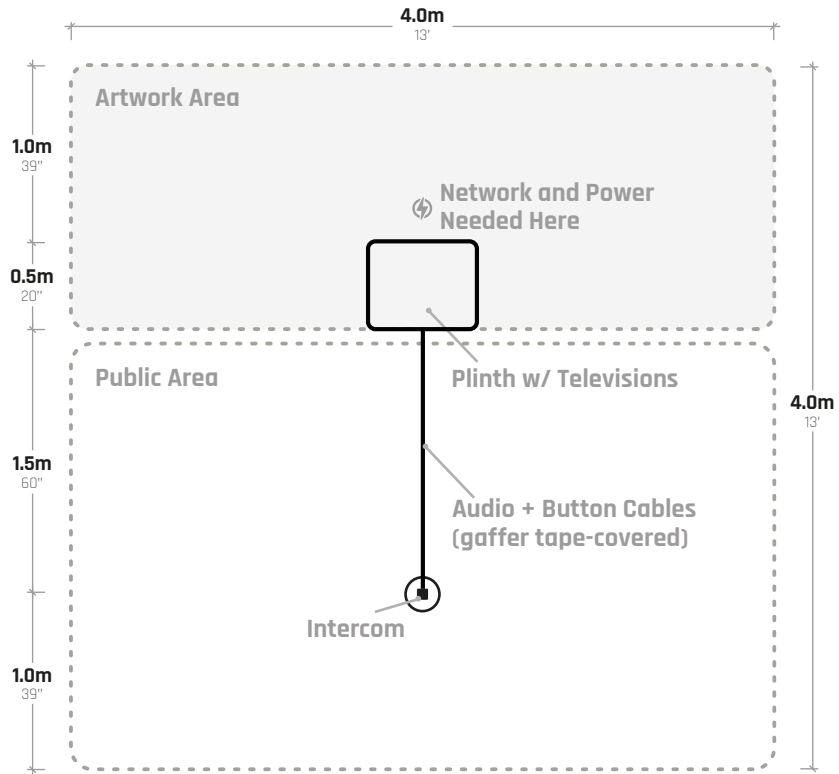
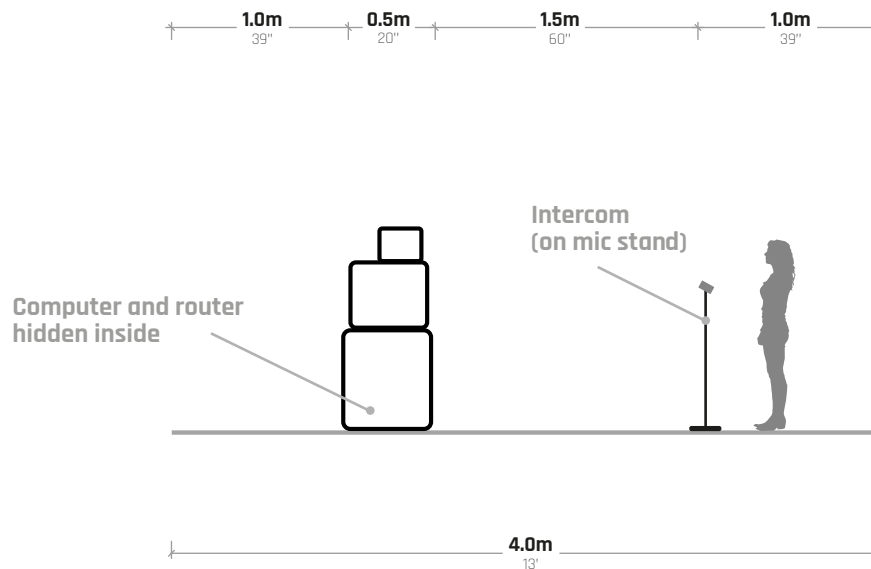


Top View

Shipping



Host Must Provide:

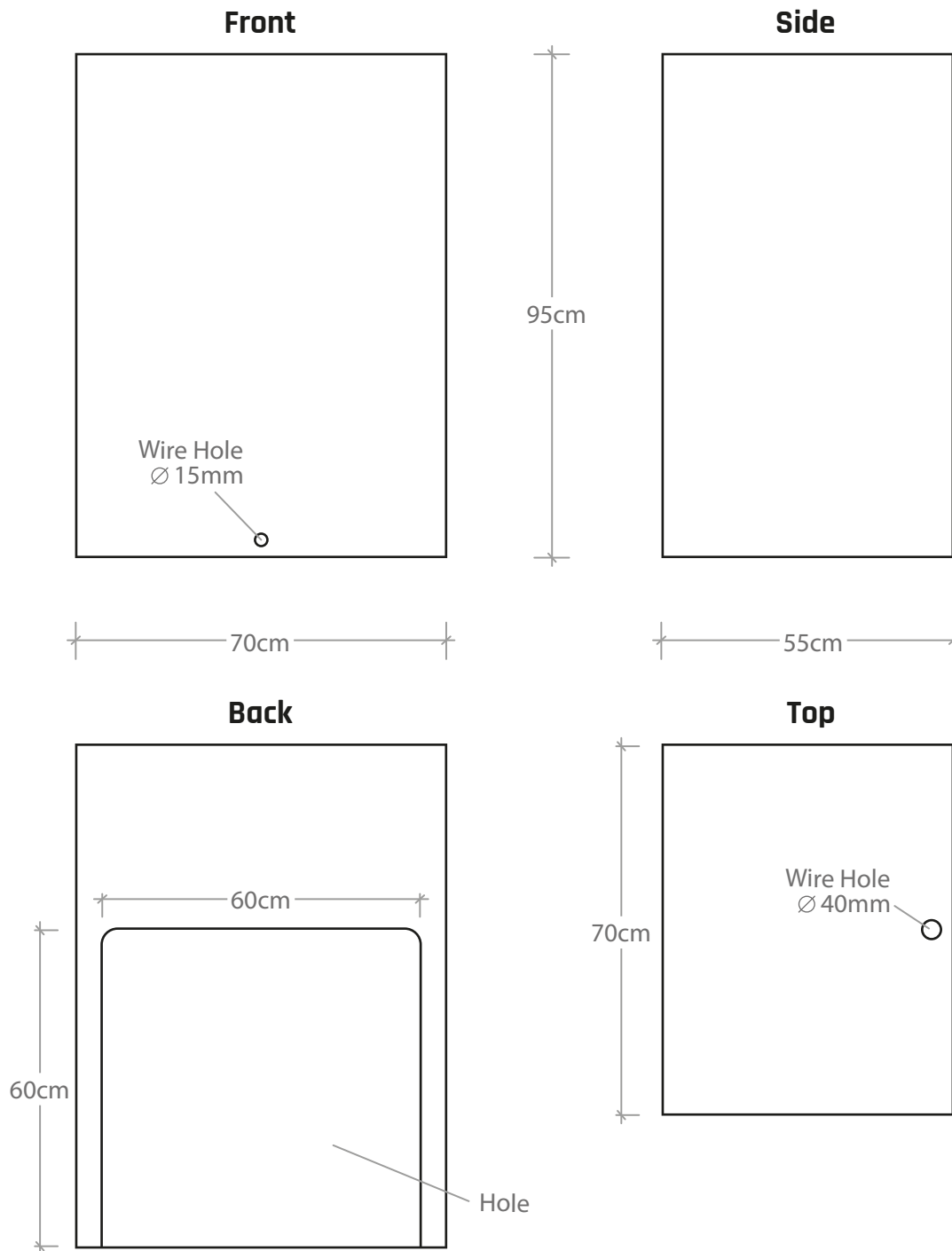
- **Electricity** Standard 100VAC-240VAC circuits at 50/60Hz for computer, monitor, router, and accessories. Installation power draw is about **550 W**.

If local electrical supply is unstable, host must provide a suitable UPS (uninterruptible power supply) or regulator on properly grounded circuit.
- **Environment** Dark room with no competing sounds.
- **Lighting** If the room is very dark, two PAR lights must be installed so the cameras can detect the user's face (to be discussed).
- **Television** The large television can be shipped but it is expensive. It is much cheaper to locally buy a PAL or NTSC cathode-ray tube (CRT) 50cm (20", diagonal) used television (to be discussed).
- **Plinth** A plinth (pedestal) must be provided to set the televisions on. See next page for specs.
- **Network** Reliable high speed, wired Internet access is mandatory. If unavailable, a cellular access point can also be set up (to be discussed).
- **Accessibility** To make it accessible to kids, a step should be provided. Mic is too high for wheelchair-bound individuals (can be adapted on request).

Additional Details:

- **Setup time** 4 hrs by artist himself (if lighting is already set up), 3 hrs for teardown.
- **Insurance** The insurance and/or customs value for artist-owned equipments is 5000\$CA (computer, keyboard, mouse, screen, router, license dongle, RF modulators, televisions, stand, intercom, cabling and accessories).
- **Localization** The UI can easily be updated to match local language. Audio stories are told in the user's language.
